Appetizers will be served from 6 - 7:30 p.m. Beverages will be served all evening. The live auction generally lasts until 10:30 or 11 p.m. Checkout begins at 9 p.m.*

BUY OUT BIDS

*The bidding on a silent auction piece will be closed once a buy out bid is made. The buy out price is determined by the Artists Coalition and is listed for each artwork. Pieces must stay on display through the auction.*

SPECIAL RESERVE SEAT TICKETS

*A limited number of reserved seats - up front, where you can really follow the bidding are available for \$100. Reserve seats must be purchased by Wednesday, February 15 at 9 p.m. The price of this special ticket is not refundable.*
